Electric Vehicle Charging



- Tualatin received a \$15 Million grant to bring publicly accessible EV charging infrastructure to the region
- Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grant Program, U.S. Department of Transportation
- Estimated 500 chargers at 125 unique sites across 17 different cities
- Chargers will be sited at multifamily housing properties and public facilities
- Partnering with Forth and PGE



2025 Legislative Agenda



- We are impacted by decisions and policies made at the state and federal levels
- We have dedicated a lot of time to implementing state legislation at the local level, advocating for Tualatin's interests, and pursuing outside funding
- Thorn Run Partners hired to represent Tualatin in Salem and Washington D.C.
- In August, the City Council adopted the 2025 Legislative Agenda, which includes funding requests for three key community projects
 - Seismic Valving at Six Water Reservoirs
 - Veteran's Plaza Shade Structure
 - Electric Vehicle Chargers

Martinazzi Sewer Upsizing

- Build a new sewer main and replace an old water main along Martinazzi Avenue from Seminole Trail to Sagert Street
- Martinazzi is now closed from Sagert Street to Avery Street until December
- Water main construction began on 9/30 and the new pipe is mostly complete
- Sewer construction to begin this week and last through November
- Final phase of the project is to repave Martinazzi Avenue through the project area and along Sagert Street from the I-5 bridge



Parks and Trails Bond

- Objective to improve athletic fields, improve play equipment, increase trail connections, and create new water access
- Completed Projects:
 - Tualatin River Greenway Trail Extension (under Hwy 99)
 - Jurgens, Atfalati, and Ibach Parks Playgrounds
 - Community Park Field Lights
 - Atfalati Park Picnic Shelter
 - Park Acquisitions (17 Acres in Basalt Creek, 6 Acres of Riverfront)
- In Process:
 - Nyberg Creek Trail Connection
 - Athletic Fields Improvement
 - Veterans Plaza
